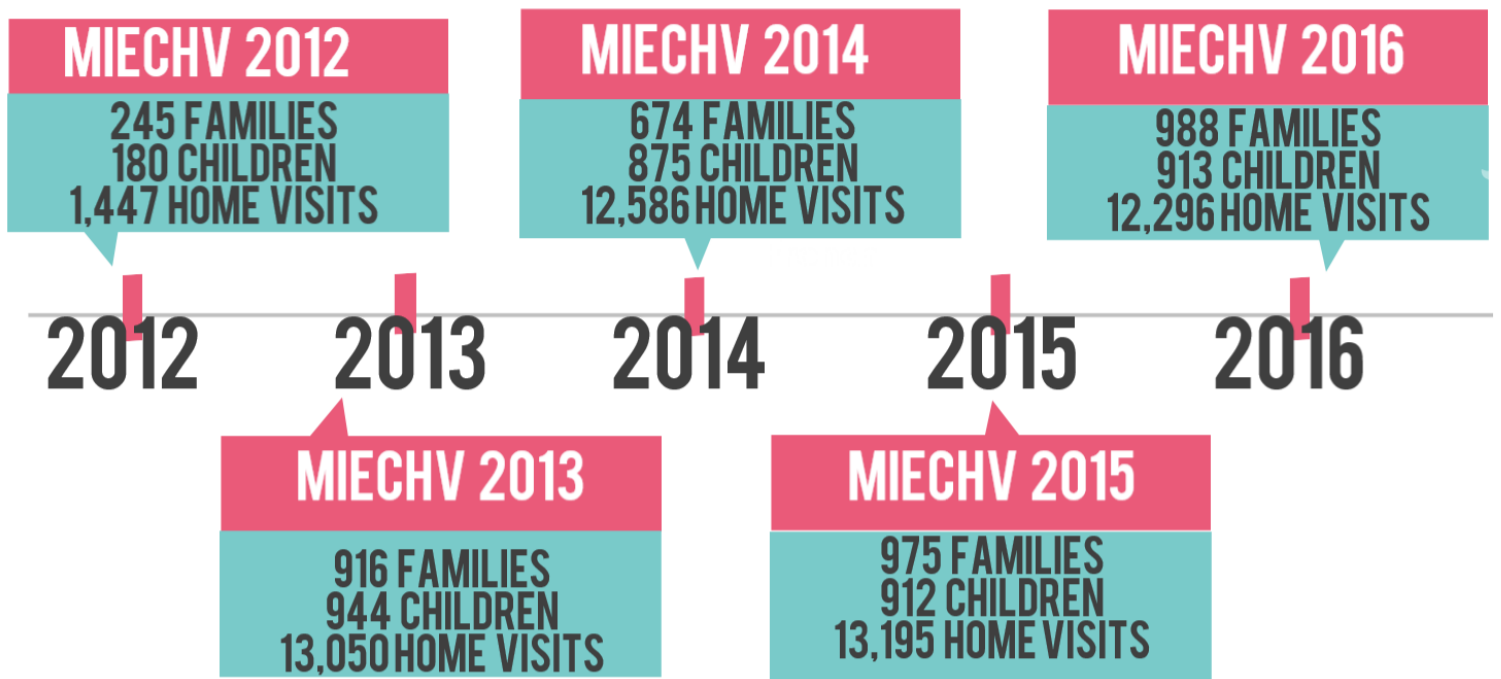


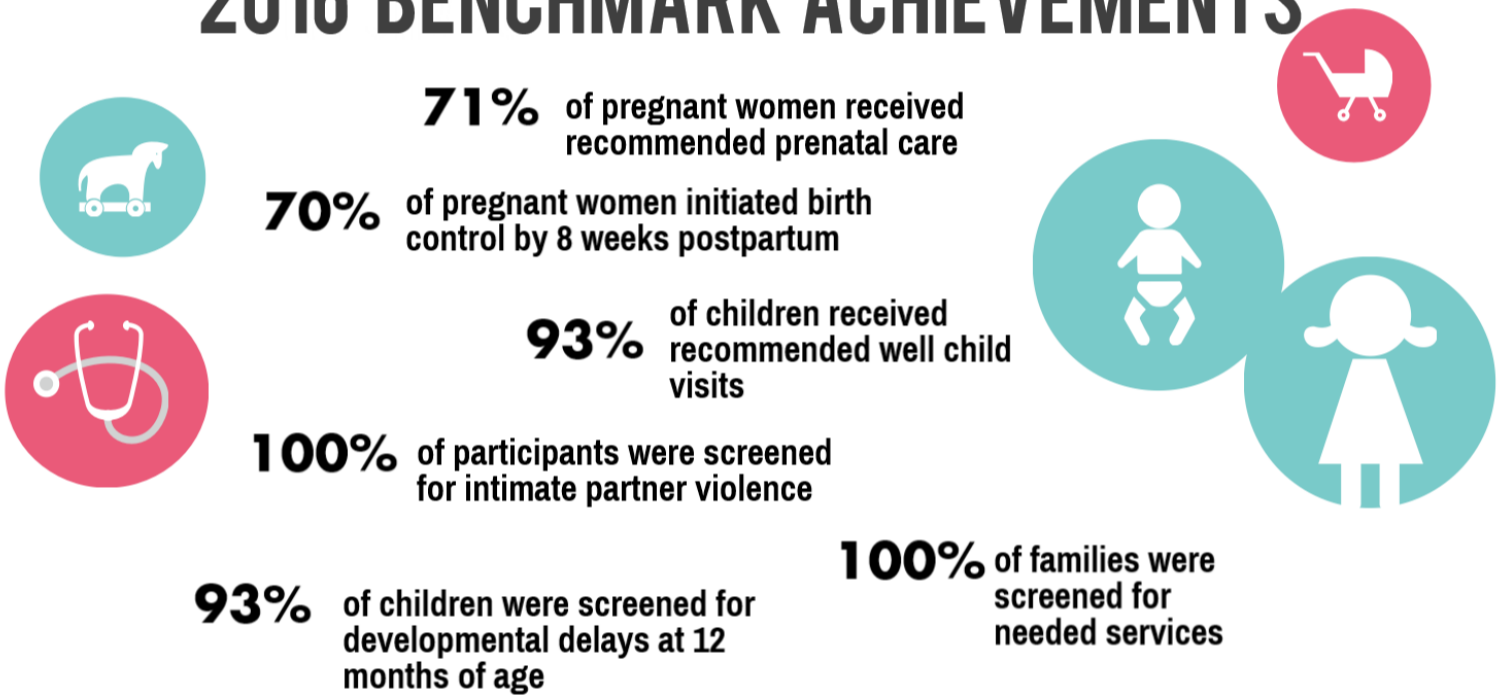

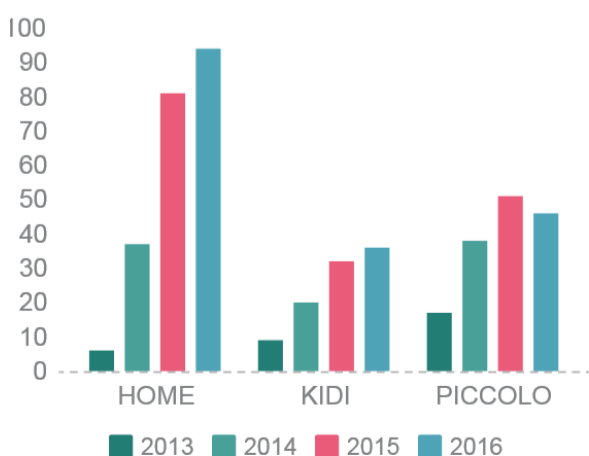

The KIDI, HOME, and PICCOLO measure parenting knowledge and behaviors linked to school readiness and academic achievement.
