Benchmark Results

Healthy Growth and Development

92% of children received a parent-child interaction assessment

32% of infants breastfed for at least 6 months



Safety in the Home

93% of children under age 1 were screened for safe sleep practices

79% of guardians received Intimate Partner Violence screening within 6 months of enrollment

School Readiness

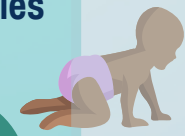
49% of families engage in daily literacy activities



81% of children were screened for developmental delays

Maternal Health and Wellbeing

84% of guardians were screened for depression within 3 months of enrollment or delivery



66% received postpartum care within 56 days after childbirth
